



CARE & MAINTENANCE - PINETRIM TIMBER

Hume Pinetrim mouldings are a natural product and are manufactured from sustainable plantation grown Pine. Hume Pinetrim uses a manufacturing process that removes all knots and visible imperfections and is fingerjointed for increased stability.

It is important to remember that timber is a natural product and that it will react to changes in climatic conditions during the life of the product. Uneven swelling, raised grain and resin bleed are generally due to varying climatic conditions.

As the product is kiln dried, care must be taken to ensure the product remains dry at all times during storage and delivery to site. Kiln dried timber will absorb moisture from the atmosphere, which can lead to dimensional change by expanding and contracting according to the moisture content of the product. Pinetrim must be stored on a well ventilated level surface, on bearers at least 150mm off the ground, protected from direct sunlight and moisture. The profiles need to be protected from moisture, excessive heat, and direct sunlight. Remove the profiles from their packaging and allow them to reach EMC (Equilibrium Moisture Content) prior to installation.
